Eligibility

1. The candidate should be a Graduate in Veterinary Sciences and registered with the Veterinary Council of India/State Veterinary Council.
2. Has maintained a membership status, as Life Member of IAVP, by virtue of specialization (Master or Ph.D.) in the discipline of Veterinary Pathology.
3. **Has completed at least three calendar years of supervised training** during or after Master in Veterinary Pathology that is acceptable to the College Council, as the **standard** route of training. Normally, the acceptable supervised training is under the supervision & direction of Diplomate of the Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists as given in the application. The training may be conducted simultaneously with M.V.Sc. or Ph. D. program in Veterinary Pathology.

OR

The candidate must have three years full time exposure in Veterinary Pathology (after acquiring post-graduate qualification), including **a minimum period of one calendar year of training**, normally under the supervision of a Diplomate of the Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists, as an **alternate** route of training.
